Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop employing just 4 individuals. Total sales for that particular year totaled \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various components. Within five years of operation, the company had stretched to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is amongst the top international producers within the material handling business.

Design and production of the company's original hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue better business possibilities. Throughout the final sixty years, the business of material handling has developed into a very complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade presently continues to grow as the premier provider of forklift accessories and various associated products. The business feels confident in their capability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the international market.

Throughout the 1950's, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and advertise its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was built in 1956, in order to accommodate all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present head office. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second production facility was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the business recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. The company has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the U.S. with places in Portland, Oregon, Springfield, Ohio, and Warner Robins, Georgia. Cascade products are fabricated globally thanks to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of 5 companies, together with the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
